MIME & MASQUE DRAMA SCHOLARSHIP

Mime and Masque is proposing a scholarship in the amount of **\$500** to be given to one senior annually. The name of this scholarship shall be “The Mime and Masque Drama Scholarship.” The purpose of this scholarship is to supply financial aid to a college bound student interested in pursuing a career in the performing arts.

All students applying for this scholarship must fill out the Sandpoint High School common Scholarship Application and the essays that accompany it. In addition, all applicants must meet the following criteria: 3.0 weighted GPA; students must have completed two (2) semesters of a drama, performing arts, or theater class, which includes, but is not limited to drama, acting, theater, Theater 101 and technical theater; students must have an involvement in theater, which includes, but is not limited to Mime & Masque, high school productions, professional or community productions, or technical theater of any type; and students must be planning to attend college to pursue a degree in performing arts, which includes, but is not limited to theater, communications (television), dramatic arts, fine arts, technical theater and acting.

A scholarship committee shall choose the winner of the scholarship. The scholarship committee shall consist of the Mime & Masque Advisor, President, Vice President, and Secretary Treasurer. The winner shall be announced at senior awards night. The award must be claimed by January 31st, or the award will be returned to the scholarship fund. The money will be awarded to college after proof of enrollment is given to Sandpoint High School.
